Thank you for your request received on 26th March 2021. Your request has been dealt with under the terms of the above legislation. You requested the following information:

- 1) The most recent 2021 figures available (in previous years, as at 31 March) regarding
 - households on the social housing waiting list in Northern Ireland
 - households considered to be in housing stress (with 30 points or more) in Northern Ireland
 - households with FDA status in Northern Ireland.
- 2) The most recent 2021 figures available (in previous years, as at 31 March) regarding children under the age of 18
 - in households on the social housing waiting list in NI.
 - in households considered to be in housing stress in NI.
 - in households with FDA status in NI.

In past years this information has been provided by yourselves at the NIHE FOI team in Excel table form as below (broken down by family type and from which we calculated the minimum possible number of children included). We would the fullest set of data possible; at a minimum, please send the updated figures from your system in this same level of detail.
